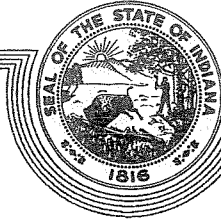

**MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES**

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**PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL RATES**

**1. TERMS OF PAYMENT**

Bills for service shall be rendered and due monthly. If paid on or before the due date as stated on the bill, the net bill shall be the amount to be paid. If not paid on or before the due date as stated on the bill, the gross bill, which includes the late payment charge, shall be the amount to be paid. When the stated due date falls on Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday, payment shall be due the first business day following the stated due date.

**2. LATE PAYMENT CHARGE**

In the event that the current monthly billing is not paid on or before the stated due date, a late payment charge of ten percent (10%) for the first \$3.00, plus three percent (3%) of the amount in excess of the first \$3.00 will be added to the net bill. The gross amount due as shown on the billing statement includes the late payment charge.

**3. INTERPRETATION**

Upon application by Northeastern or any customer, the interpretation or application of all rates included in this tariff by Northeastern REMC (Northeastern) or by any customer/owner (customer) shall be subject to review by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission, or by the governing body having jurisdiction.

**4. SECURITY DEPOSIT FOR SERVICE**

If a customer applying for service had been served by Northeastern previously and did not pay their final bill, a deposit equal to three (3) months estimated usage or seventy-five dollars (\$75), whichever is greater, may be required.

If an existing customer has been disconnected for non-payment two (2) times within a twelve (12) month period, upon reconnection of service the second time, a deposit of three (3) months estimated usage or seventy-five (\$75), whichever is greater, may be required.

The required deposit amount must be provided at the time the customer requests service connection.

If at the end of a twelve (12) month period the customer has met the "Terms of Payment," the deposit amount will be refunded, credited to the customer's account or credited to the customer's final bill at the customer's option.

**5. COLLECTION CHARGE**

When Northeastern dispatches an employee to the premises of a customer to collect a delinquent bill or to disconnect service, the customer will incur a charge of \$45.00. The charge will still apply if the customer makes payment by phone or at Northeastern's offices while the employee is en route to the customer's premises.

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## **6. RECONNECTION CHARGE**

When a Northeastern employee disconnects service for non-payment of bills and the customer requests reconnection during normal business hours, the customer must pay a charge of \$45.00 before Northeastern will reconnect such service. If the customer, at his option, requests such service to be reconnected after normal business hours, an overtime charge of \$95.00 must be paid by the customer before Northeastern will reconnect such service.

When a Northeastern lineman, using an aerial bucket truck, disconnects service for non-payment of bills and the customer requests reconnection during normal business hours, the customer must pay a charge of \$45.00 before Northeastern will reconnect such service. If the customer, at his option, requests such service to be reconnected after normal business hours, an overtime charge of \$195.00 must be paid by the customer before Northeastern will reconnect such service.

When a reconnection of service is made for the same customer at the same location within a twelve (12) month period, where service was disconnected at the customer's request, a charge of \$45.00 shall be paid for such reconnection.

## **7. INSUFFICIENT FUNDS CHARGE**

When a check received in payment of a customer's account is returned, the customer shall be assessed a handling charge of \$15.00 for each check returned by the bank. Electronic payments made either through Northeastern REMC's web site or through a paying agent service, which are returned non-payable, shall be assessed a handling charge of \$15.00 for each returned item.

## **8. METER READING CHARGE**

When an abnormal condition (locked gate, cross dog, etc.) exists and requires a special trip to obtain the meter reading, the customer will be charged \$30.00 per trip. This charge will be added to the customer's monthly bill.

## **9. METER TEST AT REQUEST OF CUSTOMER**

Northeastern will endeavor to maintain the efficiency of the meters within the allowable accuracy prescribed by the Indiana Administrative Code Title 170 Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission Article 4 Electric Utility. Northeastern will make a test of accuracy of registration on a meter upon a written request of a customer. If the customer requests a meter test within twelve (12) months of the last test and no error is found, then the customer will be charged \$45.00 for the meter test. This charge will be added to the customer's monthly bill.

## **10. SAME DAY SERVICE CHARGE**

Should a customer request a meter be installed or a meter reading be taken on the same day they pay their membership, Northeastern will charge \$45.00 during normal business hours and \$95.00 after normal business hours for this service. These charges are non-refundable.

## **11. CUSTOMER FALSE CALL-OUT CHARGE**

If Northeastern personnel respond to a customer call and discover the cause of the power outage is located on customer's side of the meter (e.g., tripped breaker, blown fuse, etc.), a charge of \$95.00 during normal business hours and a charge of \$195.00 after normal business hours will be assessed. Northeastern is not obligated to make repairs to the customer's equipment, which is located on customer's side of the meter.

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**12. TEMPORARY FACILITIES CHARGE**

The intent of temporary service is to provide light-duty electrical service, in accordance with the Corporation's "Electric Standards Manual", for construction purposes until a permanent service has been established.

Northeastern will furnish necessary pole and entrance equipment for temporary service. Northeastern may require the customer to pay, in advance, a one-time \$125.00 charge for each temporary service. The applicable billing rate will also apply to energy use for this service.

If the customer or its representative (e.g., contractor) provides their own temporary service facilities, Northeastern may require the customer to pay, in advance, a one-time \$100.00 charge for each service connection. In addition, the customer shall incur a \$25.00 inspection charge for each trip.

**13. CUSTOMER OR OUTSIDE PARTY FAULT CHARGE**

Northeastern shall bill persons damaging its property (broken pole, buried cable cut, etc.) for the cost of repairing such damage. These costs shall include, but are not limited to, labor, transportation, materials, etc. needed to effect permanent repairs.

**14. CUSTOMER WIRING INSPECTION CHARGE**

If a customer or its representative (contractor) requests an inspection, the initial trip is at no charge. Should the inspection fail, an additional trip for re-inspection will be made at no charge. If additional trips are required, the customer or its representative making the request will be charged \$25.00 per trip.
